Our Donations

Clothing, bedding and shoes are donated by members of the public along with schools, faith organisations, educational organisations, hoteliers and retail businesses

- Sufferers of poor mental health
- Discharges from hospital
- Temporarily homeless
- Refugees and asylum seekers

Our Impact

With the supply of clothing people are able to; attend interviews leading to work and training, send their children to school, have a supply of clothes to go to work until they get out of debt, keep warm, dry and healthy. Referrals can also access other support services, move out of negative networks and rebuild their lives by combating their current crises and creating change.

Distribution

Bulk deliveries are made to organisations helping large numbers of people in need of clothing such as Nottingham and Mansfield YMCA, Nottingham & Notts Refugee Forum, and the British Red Cross.



Outreach

Existing organisations take pre-packed parcels of clothes for individuals and give them to clients presenting a need at their service. This eliminates the need for an extra journey to their clients.

Referrals

Charities and other organisations refer clients to Sharewear including: Children's Centres, NHS teams, Nottinghamshire Police, homeless organisations, food banks, schools and colleges





Our History

Sharewear Clothing Scheme was put into action in 2014 by founder Louise Cooke, who became aware that individuals and families in crisis had no access to much needed clothing, shoes and bedding. Sharewear is the only scheme of its kind in the country.The Scheme is run with over 30 volunteers and 11 board members and currently there are no paid staff. Many of the client referrals become volunteers themselves and learn new skills.

OUR FUNDING

The main funding sources are direct debit donations and fundraising events. Clothing and bedding donated that is not suitable for distribution is sold onto the rag trade instead of going to landfill. This can provide a small monthly income which is used for volunteer expenses. Sharewear has also been previously supported financially by Councillor's Ward Budgets from the following Nottingham City wards: Bestwood, Bulwell Forest, and Berridge.
